I oppose this bill with the fullness of my being. Everything relevant in the data category got logged in your public hearing, so here's what feels worth adding:

We are at a fragile time in human history. What appears to be the biggest threat to all of us is division itself. I oppose destroying a generation of immune systems, weakening the body's natural resilience to adapt to an exponentially toxic world. I oppose having my child or myself become an experimental object in the process of wide-sweeping public health strategies. I oppose a government that will prioritize political status, ego, and capitalism over the well-being of its citizens. I believe this is contrary to the intent behind democracy. You can dismiss this if you like, but to some degree, it is all truth, and some part of you knows it.

I am absolutely FOR strong immune systems! No one asked to co-exist with these nasty viruses and I certainly don't want anyone to suffer. But unlimited vaccines, in their current archaic and highly-toxic forms, are NOT. THE. ANSWER.

Among developed nations, the US spends the most on child healthcare, and, by many health metrics, is embarrassingly behind. It's time we really dig into what is behind this. Yes, as the pro-vaccine folks will say (because it's basically all they have), 'correlation is not causation.' Absolutely, I agree. But, isn't it integral to the scientific method, that when we see correlations to this degree and with the highest stakes, that we apply curiosity and investigation?
