SUMMARY

Deletes residential address of public body employee or volunteer exemption from public record disclosure.

Modifies certain care worker information exemptions from public record disclosure.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure removes the exemption from public disclosure for residential addresses of employees and volunteers of public bodies. The measure also subjects to mandatory public disclosure residential addresses and personal electronic mail addresses of home care workers, personal support workers, operators of child care facilities, exempt family child care providers and operators of adult foster care homes.

This measure subjects the specified public records to mandatory disclosure under public records law.
