SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Clarifies that bicycle lane continues in and through intersection where markings are interrupted by intersection.]

Clarifies that bicycle lane exists in intersection if bicycle lane is marked on opposite sides of intersection in same direction of travel.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to bicycle lanes; amending ORS 801.155.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 801.155 is amended to read:

5 801.155. "Bicycle lane" means that part of the highway, adjacent to the roadway, designated by
6 official signs or markings for use by persons riding bicycles except as otherwise specifically provided
7 by law. **A bicycle lane exists in an intersection if the bicycle lane is marked on opposite sides**
8 **of the intersection in the same direction of travel.**
