SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits sale, purchase or use of pesticide chlorpyrifos.
Requires State Department of Agriculture to place pesticide products containing neonicotinoid on list of restricted-use pesticides.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to pesticides.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Sections 2 to 4 of this 2019 Act are added to and made a part of ORS chapter**
5 **634.**

6 **SECTION 2. A person may not sell, purchase or use a pesticide product containing**
7 **chlorpyrifos in this state.**

8 **SECTION 3. On the effective date of this 2019 Act, the State Department of Agriculture**
9 **shall immediately revoke any registration issued under ORS 634.016 prior to the effective**
10 **date of this 2019 Act for a pesticide product containing chlorpyrifos.**

11 **SECTION 4. (1) As used in this section, "neonicotinoid" means:**

12 **(a) Acetamiprid;**

13 **(b) Clothianidin;**

14 **(c) Dinotefuran;**

15 **(d) Imidacloprid;**

16 **(e) Nithiazine;**

17 **(f) Thiacloprid;**

18 **(g) Thiamethoxam; or**

19 **(h) Any other chemical the State Department of Agriculture determines by rule to belong**
20 **to the neonicotinoid class of chemical compounds.**

21 **(2) The department shall list a pesticide product that contains a neonicotinoid as a**
22 **restricted-use pesticide under ORS 634.316.**
