

Senate Bill 21

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Department of Human Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to human services any changes needed to statutes governing programs administered by department due to changes to budget.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to programs administered by the Department of Human Services; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. No later than September 15, 2019, the Department of Human Services shall**
6 **report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services any**
7 **changes to statutes governing the programs administered by the department that are nec-**
8 **essary to implement changes to the department's budget, if any, that were made during the**
9 **2019 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
