

Senate Bill 312

Sponsored by Senator HANSELL (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public universities and community colleges to charge resident tuition to Native Americans and Alaska Natives who graduated from Oregon high schools.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to resident tuition for indigenous people; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 or a community college shall**
5 **charge an enrolled student who is not a resident of this state and who is attending classes**
6 **as an undergraduate or graduate student on a public university or community college cam-**
7 **pus in this state tuition and fees no greater than the resident rate if the student:**

8 (a)(A) **Is Native American; or**

9 (B) **Is an Alaska Native; and**

10 (b)(A) **Received a diploma under ORS 329.451;**

11 (B) **Completed grade 12 in compliance with the requirements of ORS 339.035; or**

12 (C) **Completed grade 12 at a private or parochial school, as described in ORS 339.030**

13 (1)(a).

14 (2) **As used in this section:**

15 (a) **"Alaska Native" means an individual who is an Eskimo or Aleut or other Alaska Na-**
16 **tive; and**

17 (b) **"Native American" means an individual who:**

18 (A) **Is a member of a federally recognized Native American tribe or band, as defined by**
19 **the tribe or band;**

20 (B) **Is a member of a Native American tribe or band, as defined by the tribe or band, that**
21 **had the tribe or band's federal recognition terminated in 1940 or later; or**

22 (C) **Is a member of a Native American tribe that is historically based in Oregon, as de-**
23 **termined by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission by rule.**

24 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act first applies to the 2019-2020 academic year.**

25 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
26 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
27 **on its passage.**
