

Senate Bill 382

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Judiciary)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Removes limit of 20 pounds on transfer of usable marijuana from medical marijuana grow site to recreational marijuana processor or wholesaler.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transfers of marijuana; amending ORS 475B.825.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475B.825 is amended to read:

5 475B.825. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, a marijuana grow site may transfer [*up to*
6 *20 pounds of*] usable marijuana [*per year*] to a person that holds a license issued under ORS 475B.090
7 or 475B.100, provided that:

8 (a) The transfer is tracked using the system developed and maintained under ORS 475B.177;

9 (b) More than 12 mature marijuana plants are produced at the marijuana grow site;

10 (c) The usable marijuana has been assigned to the person responsible for the marijuana grow
11 site pursuant to ORS 475B.822;

12 (d) The usable marijuana has been tested in accordance with the provisions of ORS 475B.550 to
13 475B.590; and

14 (e) The marijuana grow site first registered with the Oregon Health Authority under ORS
15 475B.810 on or before August 2, 2017.

16 (2) If the Oregon Liquor Control Commission determines that the supply of marijuana items of-
17 fered for sale by marijuana retailers that hold a license issued under ORS 475B.105 is exceeding
18 consumer demand for the marijuana items, and if the commission determines that the market for
19 marijuana items in this state will not self-correct for the excess, the commission may issue an order
20 that temporarily reduces the amount of usable marijuana that may be transferred pursuant to this
21 section or that temporarily suspends the ability to transfer usable marijuana pursuant to this sec-
22 tion.
