

# Senate Bill 859

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Exempts graduate students at public universities who qualify for tuition equity from having to pay nonresident tuition.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to scope of tuition equity at public universities; creating new provisions; amending ORS  
3 352.287; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 352.287, as amended by section 1, chapter 122, Oregon Laws 2018, is amended  
6 to read:

7 352.287. (1) The governing board of a public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall exempt a  
8 student who is not a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States from paying non-  
9 resident tuition and fees for enrollment **as an undergraduate student and as a graduate student**  
10 in a **degree program at a public university listed in ORS 352.002** if the student:

11 (a) During each of the three years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma or a  
12 modified diploma or leaving school before receiving a high school diploma or a modified diploma,  
13 attended an elementary or a secondary school in this state;

14 (b) During each of the five years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma or a  
15 modified diploma or leaving school before receiving a high school diploma or a modified diploma,  
16 attended an elementary or a secondary school in any state or territory of the United States, the  
17 District of Columbia or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico;

18 (c) Received a high school diploma or a modified diploma from a secondary school in this state  
19 or received the equivalent of a high school diploma; and

20 (d) Shows intention to become a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States by  
21 submitting to the public university the student attends or plans to attend an official copy of the  
22 student's application to register with a federal immigration program or federal deportation deferral  
23 program or a statement of intent that the student will seek to obtain citizenship as permitted under  
24 federal law.

25 (2) The governing board shall exempt a student who is financially dependent upon a person who  
26 is not a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States from paying nonresident tuition  
27 and fees for enrollment **as an undergraduate student and as a graduate student in a degree**  
28 **program at a public university listed in ORS 352.002** if the student:

29 (a) During each of the three years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma or a  
30 modified diploma or leaving school before receiving a high school diploma or a modified diploma,

1 attended an elementary or a secondary school in this state and resided in this state with the person  
 2 upon whom the student is dependent;

3 (b) During each of the five years immediately prior to receiving a high school diploma or a  
 4 modified diploma or leaving school before receiving a high school diploma or a modified diploma,  
 5 attended an elementary or a secondary school in any state or territory of the United States, the  
 6 District of Columbia or the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and resided with the person upon whom  
 7 the student is dependent;

8 (c) Received a high school diploma or a modified diploma from a secondary school in this state  
 9 or received the equivalent of a high school diploma; and

10 (d) For a student who is not already a citizen or lawful permanent resident of the United States,  
 11 shows intention to become a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States by submit-  
 12 ting to the public university the student attends or plans to attend an official copy of the student's  
 13 application to register with a federal immigration program or federal deportation deferral program  
 14 or a statement of intent that the student will seek to obtain citizenship as permitted under federal  
 15 law.

16 (3) A student who is a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States and who has  
 17 resided outside of Oregon for more than three years while serving in the Armed Forces of the  
 18 United States, but who otherwise meets the requirements of subsection (1) or (2) of this section, shall  
 19 qualify for exemption from nonresident tuition and fees for enrollment **as an undergraduate stu-**  
 20 **dent and a graduate student** in a **degree program at a** public university listed in ORS 352.002  
 21 without having to reestablish residency in Oregon.

22 (4) The governing board shall adopt standards to implement the provisions of this section.

23 (5) Not later than July 1 of each year, the Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall  
 24 report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate and the interim  
 25 committees of the Legislative Assembly with subject matter authority over higher education, for the  
 26 preceding academic year:

27 (a) The number of students that applied and were accepted into public universities under sub-  
 28 sections (1) to (3) of this section; and

29 (b) The financial impact of subsections (1) to (3) of this section on public universities listed in  
 30 ORS 352.002.

31 (6) A student who is not a citizen or a lawful permanent resident of the United States is eligible  
 32 to receive scholarships and other financial aid from public universities listed in ORS 352.002.

33 **SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 352.287 by section 1 of this 2019 Act apply to tuition**  
 34 **charged by public universities listed in ORS 352.002 on or after the effective date of this 2019**  
 35 **Act.**

36 **SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
 37 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**  
 38 **on its passage.**
