

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1530

2 On page 40, line 43, delete “as consistent with section 56 of this 2020 Act”.

3 On page 46, delete lines 28 and 29 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 55. Section 56 of this 2020 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter**
5 **757.”.**

6 In line 30, delete “55” and insert “56”.

7 Delete lines 35 through 45.

8 On page 47, delete lines 1 through 18.

9 On page 69, delete lines 21 through 45.

10 On page 70, delete lines 1 through 28 and insert:

11 **“NOTE:** Sections 76 to 79 were deleted by amendment. Subsequent sections were not renum-
12 bered.”.

13 On page 93, delete lines 27 through 36 and insert:

14 **“SECTION 108. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-**
15 **propriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium ending June**
16 **30, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,000,000 for deposit in the Traded Sector**
17 **Greenhouse Gas Reduction Revolving Loan Fund established under section 51 of this 2020**
18 **Act.**

19 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$500,000 is es-**
20 **tablished for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-**
21 **penditures by the Oregon Business Development Department from the Traded Sector**
22 **Greenhouse Gas Reduction Revolving Loan Fund established under section 51 of this 2020**
23 **Act.**

24 **“(3) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the**
25 **Department of Environmental Quality, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the**
26 **General Fund, the amount of \$8,877,792 for expenses related to the implementation of the**
27 **Oregon Greenhouse Gas Initiative.**

28 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**
29 **established by section 2 (1), chapter 663, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30,**
30 **2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,**
31 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, the proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and**
32 **federal funds from congestion mitigation and air quality grants, drinking water protection,**
33 **beach bacteria monitoring, laboratory accreditation and woodstove grants and for smoke**
34 **monitoring laboratory services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described**
35 **in section 2, chapter 663, Oregon Laws 2019, collected or received by the Department of En-**

1 vironmental Quality, for air quality, is increased by \$145,722 for development and implemen-
2 tation of new regulations on the monitoring and control of methane emissions from certain
3 solid waste landfills.

4 “(5) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the
5 Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the
6 General Fund, the amount of \$100,000 for expenses related to the reporting requirements
7 established under section 95e of this 2020 Act.

8 “(6) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
9 established by section 2 (6), chapter 692, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30,
10 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
11 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or
12 received by the Department of Justice, for the General Counsel Division, is increased by
13 \$455,597 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

14 “(7) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
15 established by section 2 (7), chapter 518, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30,
16 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
17 including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received from charges, but excluding lot-
18 tery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 518, Oregon Laws 2019, col-
19 lected or received by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for Enterprise
20 Goods and Services, is increased by \$307,170 to study options for awarding state procurement
21 contracts that account for the greenhouse gas emissions implications of transporting goods
22 and services to Oregon and develop a model program for local governments and special gov-
23 ernment bodies to follow in planning to procure zero-emission vehicles.

24 “(8) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
25 to the State Department of Agriculture by section 1 (3), chapter 452, Oregon Laws 2019, for
26 the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for natural resources, is increased by \$111,536 to provide
27 consultation and research about agricultural lands and industries and the viability of differ-
28 ent offset protocols.

29 “(9) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the
30 Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out
31 of the General Fund, the amount of \$158,091 to develop a program proposal to assist house-
32 holds that use fuels other than natural gas for residential home heating and report on the
33 proposal.

34 “(10) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
35 to the Legislative Revenue Officer by section 15, chapter 693, Oregon Laws 2019, for the
36 biennium ending June 30, 2021, is increased by \$150,000 for expenses related to the reporting
37 requirements established under section 93 of this 2020 Act.

38 “(11) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation made
39 to the Department of Land Conservation and Development by section 1 (1), chapter 669,
40 Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for the planning program, is in-
41 creased by \$327,162 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

42 “(12) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to
43 the State Forestry Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General
44 Fund, the amount of \$119,215 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020
45 Act.

1 “(13) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
2 established by section 2 (11), chapter 614, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June
3 30, 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other reven-
4 ues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received as reimbursement from the
5 United States Department of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds
6 not described in section 2, chapter 614, Oregon Laws 2019, collected or received by the De-
7 partment of Transportation, for transportation program development, is increased by
8 \$127,517 for work related to the management of the Transportation Decarbonization Invest-
9 ments Account program.

10 “(14) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures
11 established by section 1 (1), chapter 185, Oregon Laws 2019, for the biennium ending June 30,
12 2021, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,
13 including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or
14 received by the Public Utility Commission, for the utility program, is increased by \$1,349,780
15 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020 Act.

16 “(15) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to
17 the Public Utility Commission, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, out of the General
18 Fund, the amount of \$29,566 to carry out the provisions of sections 1 to 107b of this 2020
19 Act.”.
