

# House Bill 3059

Sponsored by Representative BYNUM (at the request of ACLU of Oregon)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals statute authorizing law enforcement officers to command dispersal of unlawful assemblies and arrest participants who do not disperse.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to unlawful assemblies; amending ORS 131.665; and repealing ORS 131.675.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. ORS 131.675 is repealed.**

5 **SECTION 2.** ORS 131.665 is amended to read:

6 131.665. Crimes may be prevented by the action of public officers in accordance with ORS  
7 [*131.675,*] 131.685, 131.705 to 131.735, and as otherwise authorized by law.
